Dear Mr. Dunn:

This letter is a follow up to our telephone conversation concerning the non-binding letter issued by the Public Access Counselor ("PAC") in connection with the above identified request for review filed by Mr. Tim Novak.

Upon further review of the documents, CPD has reconsidered its previous decision and is now providing records in response to your request. CR files are typically exempt from disclosure pursuant to section 7(1)(n) of FOIA because they are an integral part of the adjudication process implemented and are heavily relied upon by the CPD. However, in this instance, the responsive records do not identify a specific employee as engaging in misconduct, and any investigation taken in the instant case would not lead to the adjudication and subsequent discipline of any individual. Therefore, in this specific circumstance, the City has determined that it will waive any FOIA protection provided by section 7(1)(n). Please be advised that the determinative factor for CPD was that there was no employee identified, and thus, no adjudication or discipline would occur.

Portions of the responsive records have been redacted pursuant to exemptions in the FOIA. Specifically, section 7(1)(b) of Illinois FOIA exempts from disclosure "private information." Private information is defined in section 2(c-5) of FOIA as "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." Therefore, an employee number, home addresses, dates of birth, social security numbers, driver's license numbers and home or personal telephone numbers have been redacted pursuant to 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(b).

Moreover, section 7(1)(d)(iv) of Illinois FOIA exempts information that would “unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies.” See, Chicago Alliance for Neighborhood Safety v. City of Chicago, 348 Ill. App. 3d 188 (1st Dist. 2004). Therefore, the names, dates of birth, home addresses, social security numbers, driver’s license numbers and other information that could be used to identify the victims and/or witnesses have been redacted pursuant to 5 ILCS 140/7(1)(d)(iv).

To the extent that you consider these redactions a denial of your FOIA request, you have a right of review by the Illinois Attorney General’s Public Access Counselor, who can be contacted at 500 S. Second St., Springfield, IL 62706 or by telephone at (217)588-0486. You may also seek judicial review of a denial under 5 ILCS 140/11 of FOIA.





Complaint Log "TYPE" is Classified CR- Sworn Affidavit Not Required

ALLEGATION: It is alleged by the Complainant Lt. Denis WALSH Star #359 that between the dates of 25 APR 2004 and 29 JUN 2011 at 2452 W. Belmont Ave. Area 3 Detective Division, that unknown Chicago Police Officer(s) had removed the investigative file related to RD #HK 323454 without permission, in violation of department rules and regulations.

SUMMARY

The P/SGT was assigned to this investigation on 21 JUL 2011. The original Packet contained attachments 1 and 4.

On 29 JUN 2011 at 2139hrs the Complainant, Lieutenant WALSH Star #359 assigned to Area 3 Detective Division found the homicide file of RD #HK-323454. This file, previous to being found by the complainant could not be located and was believed to have been lost. The file was found lying on the top shelf of a filing cabinet located in the Sergeants office of Area 3 Violent Crimes, this area had been previously searched numerous times in an attempt to try and locate the missing file. In his statement the complainant stated that he had been looking for this file since Jan. of 2011. The complainant stated that this particular file along with other homicide files are not locked up and are kept in a filing cabinet in the Violent Crimes office and can be accessed by any Violent Crimes Detective's who are working on murder cases. The complainant stated that he does not know who may have removed this particular file from the file cabinet, and does not know who returned the file.

Based on the available evidence gathered in this investigation, and the inability to identify any accused the P/SGT finds the allegation Not Sustained.






