INVESTIGATION:

The R/D was assigned to investigate the battery of David KOSCHMAN on 25Apr04. KOSCHMAN was admitted to Northwestern Memorial Hospital, Neuro-Intensive Care Unit, Room 947. At 0930 hours, Nurse Shawan (refused further identification) was contacted by phone and said that KOSCHMAN was in critical but stable condition. She said he was unconscious, and unable to be interviewed.

The R/D in the company of Det. CLEMENS located Kevin MCCARTHY at his residence where he was interviewed. That interview is reported in summary, not verbatim.

MCCARTHY, Kevin

Kevin MCCARTHY said that on 25Apr04 he and his wife were out drinking and at approximately 0300 hours they were going to meet his wife's friend Megan McDONALD at Butch McGuire's. They exited a cab, which was faced eastbound on Division, just west of Dearborn, on to the south sidewalk. When they exited the cab, he observed two groups of approximately three male whites involved in an altercation. He said one of the groups appeared to be in their late teens, and the other group appeared to be in their late twenties. MCCARTHY said they were yelling at each other, but he did not know what they were saying, and that the group of younger males appeared to be the aggressors.

He said that they started to push each other and that one of the younger males pushed one of the older males who subsequently fell into his wife. MCCARTHY said he yelled "What the hell", and that one of the younger males then pushed him. He said he pushed his wife behind him and that his wife pulled him away from the altercation. He said as his wife was pulling him away he turned around and saw the victim on the ground, but did not see who pushed him.

MCCARTHY said that he and his wife were a short distance away and the police stopped him and questioned him. He said he wasn't sure, but he thought that one of the males in the younger group pointed him out as being involved in the altercation. MCCARTHY said that he wasn't sure of what

was said but that after a lot of communication between policemen on the radio, he was released and that he and his wife went home.

At 1520 hours the R/D contacted Northwestern Hospital and spoke to Nurse Shawan who said KOSCHMAN was in critical but stable condition. She said she could not release further information but would put the victim's mother on the phone.

KOSCHMAN, Nancy

Nancy KOSCHMAN said that her son sustained a skull fracture, that his brain was swollen, and hospital personnel were unsure of the extent of brain injury or if there was neck injury. She said her son would be sedated for at least the next five days.

KOSCHMAN said that on 25Apr04 at approximately 1100 hours she received a phone call from her son's friend Vreg SAZIAN. SAZIAN told her that her son was in the hospital as the result of an altercation. SAZIAN said that he was not there, but her son had been out with Scott ALLEN, Jim COPLAND, and David FRANCIS. KOSCHMAN said that they have all been friends since a young age, and she knows them all.

On 25 April 2004, the R/D interviewed CONNOLLY telephonically with regard to the above incident. The following is a summary of that interview and should not be considered verbatim.

CONNOLLY, Michael

Michael CONNOLLY indicated that he was with a friend, KOHLER, Phil, on Division St. when he walked into an apparent altercation between eight M/2's, divided into two groups, one of three persons and the other of five persons. To CONNOLLY the aggressors in this incident appeared to be the five persons and the victim seemed to have been in their company. CONNOLLY has no knowledge of the identity of any of the individual's involved; neither does he know the cause of the incident.

CONNOLLY saw the victim get into the center of the altercation, and then he saw the victim get 'pushed or shoved' from the group and fall to the ground.

CONNOLLY indicated that, while he had a few drinks, he was not intoxicated the night of the incident.

The R/D requested the radio transmissions to be archived, and a cassette recording.

This investigation remains in progress.
